The recipient is eligible for a scholarship of \$1,000 from the Edmond Amateur Radio Society, Inc. and the University of Central Oklahoma to be used towards tuition and/or books. The scholarship will be awarded to the student in June 2011.

The scholarship is open to high school seniors who plan to attend the University of Central Oklahoma in the fall of 2011. The student must carry a minimum of 12 hours per semester (full-time). Applicants need not be an Amateur Radio operator to apply.

The selection committee will use the requested information for the purpose of choosing a student to receive the award. All information will be kept confidential and only the members of the selection committee will see the application. The committee will consider all areas of information requested; however, no single area will preclude an applicant from receiving the scholarship.

If selected, the applicant agrees to allow his/her name to be used in publicity pertaining to the scholarship.
